During the 2009 session of the Texas Legislature, TEXAS CEC's priorities were reform of the transportation project delivery process, improved infrastructure funding, and protection of the statute of repose and certificate of merit laws. The failure of almost all transportation legislation was a major disappointment - bills to improve TxDOT's business planning and performance accountability, provide for local transportation funding options, and make other changes died in the final days of the session.

Although the subsequent special session did succeed in authorizing \$2 billion in Proposition 12 bonds, all of these major transportation policy matters left over from 2009 will be debated again in 2011. In addition, Sunset review of the TCEQ and the Water Development Board will bring environmental policy and water finance issues to the forefront.
